UPDATE ON COUNCIL COORDINATED/RUN/HOSTED EVENTS:

Venue for the annual Classic Car Show to be changed to Ascot Park. Date still the 23rd April 2017.

RESTRICTED/CONCESSIONAL REGISTRATION UPDATE:

The Dept of Transport issued its revised rules for concessional licensing for vintage, veteran and historic vehicles on 20th December. In conjunction with the DoT the CMC has developed the Concessional License Code 404 Information Booklet which specifies the detailed requirements for concessional licensing. The DoT has also developed its relevant Business Rules (not publically available) and a very useful FAQ document which is available online. Key points:

- Vehicles must generally be older than 25 years and must be unmodified (although some safety related mods are permitted any performance mods are not)
- Under exceptional circumstances concessional licenses may be granted to Unique and Historic vehicles less than 25 years old if they have limited availability in Australia or are recognised as having historic significance. Applications under this class need to be approved by the CMCWA Technical Committee
- Apart from Unique and Historic class any vehicles on a full license can be transferred to a concessional license without any inspection
- Owners of concessionally licensed vehicles must be financial members of a club authorised by the DoT (these need to be a min of 30 members). As soon as this member becomes unfinancial their concessional license is cancelled.
- Applications for concessional license need to be accompanied by a form signed by an authorised officer of a DoT approved historic motoring club certifying that the member is financial and the vehicle is unmodified
- Useage is restricted to repair/maintenance/testing within 30 km of owners residence and recorded events arranged by DoT approved clubs
