RESTRICTED/CONCESSIONAL REGISTRATION UPDATE:

- National Injury Insurance Scheme commenced 1/7/16. CTP Insurance increasing 1/10/16 to cover the cost of the NIIS.
- New Point to Point Speed Cameras installed
- The age of a vehicle to be used for ride sharing services (Uber etc) has been opened up and does not have to be 6 years old or newer. More clarification is needed regarding how old a can be and if historic vehicles can now be used.
- Tow Truck legislation in NSW Russell Manning has spoken to NSW Roads & Maritime Services. It has been confirmed that there is no issue with a person towing a vehicle for private purposes. The Legislation applies when a vehicle is being towed for business.
