### **UPDATE ON COUNCIL COORDINATED/RUN/HOSTED EVENTS:**

Council annual rally held in Narrabri at Easter 2018 was well organised. Entries came in from all over NSW & one from South Australia. This event was over the Easter weekend which attracted many visitors to view the entrants. Numbers were well down on previous rallies. It was also the AGM meeting of the CHMC. ### **RESTRICTED/CONCESSIONAL REGISTRATION UPDATE:**

The Classic Vehicle Scheme (CVS) is now up & running. The CHMC has now been accepted by the RMS as an **Approved Organisation**. CHMC has strict guidelines for acceptance to CVS. Some vehicles have been rejected due to being **WELL** outside CHMC guidelines for a Heritage/Historic/Authentic vehicle.

Another item from the RMS is the deletion of Registration Labels to be attached to HVS & CVS vehicles from 1st July 2018.
