Council's annual rally was to be held in Temora following on from the AHMF's 2020 National Motoring Festival. The unfortunate circumstances with regards to the outbreak of Covid-19 back in January/February created an unworkable environment for all those types of outdoor functions. We currently have several new clubs in the process of completing affiliation with CHMC.

- CHMC has changed the membership year and financial year from 1st January to 31st December.

- The Half Yearly meeting was held in Newcastle in October 2019. This was attended by three RMS members who gave a presentation on several issues regarding HVS & CVS registration.
- Discussions were also held regarding CHMC's 50th Anniversary to be held in October 2020.
- Information on the requirements of towing vehicles on trailers or trucks with respect of the Towing Industry.
- The AGM was postponed until October 2020.
- Meetings with Transport for NSW (previously RMS) regarding breaches of HVS & industry information.

HERITAGE VEHICLE EVENTS – PLANS/DETAILS:

There were several events throughout NSW held since June 2019 until Covid-19 hit us all. Cars & Coffee days were successful. Many clubs either hosted car shows or Swap Meets bringing in large crowds. A motoring extravaganza held at Tamworth, hosted by Rotary & supported by many clubs from the North West/New England areas. Moree hosted a major motoring extravaganza involving Trade exhibits & a large range of different aspects of motoring. Most events for 2020 have been either cancelled or postponed to a later date. The 50th Anniversary for CHMC has been postponed until the AGM & Rally in Temora 8th – 12th April 2021 – and hopefully will go ahead.

LOGBOOK REVIEW:

CHMC continues to be actively involved in the *TfNSW Logbook Review* which has moved from Phase 1 in which, as well participants from our sector, separate workshops included the Police, Insurance & Service NSW representatives.
